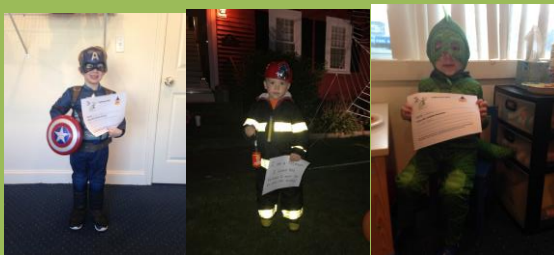

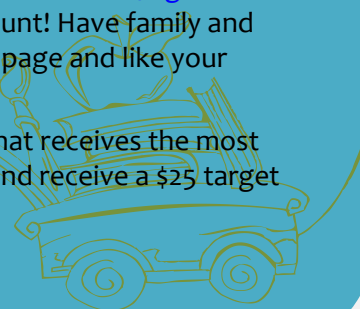


COSTUME CONTEST

“Social Thinking” Conference:



What: The “Social Thinking” curriculum, created by Michelle Garcia Winner, hosted a recent conference in Norwood! The goal of “Social Thinking” is to assist in the development of social competencies to help individuals connect with others and create a happy more meaningful life. It aides in translation of the abstract concepts involved in social communication to more concrete ideas. Two of our SLP’s at Let’s Talk, Amy Blanchette and Laura Bartus, attended the “Building Social Competencies for School and Beyond” course for children 5 and up. At this conference they learned about:

- Social Thinking’s new Social Competency Model, outlining four steps to teaching social competencies
- Tips for implementing the Social Thinking Methodology in therapy sessions
- How to create project-based learning where everyday materials are leveraged for motivating social competency lessons
- Implementing a peer coaching program in which teens and young adults can practice what they’ve learned and support peers.
